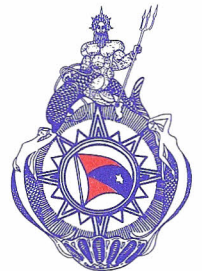

BREMERTON YACHT CLUB GUEST MOORAGE RULES

Welcome to Kitsap County and welcome to the Bremerton Yacht Club. We sincerely hope that you will enjoy your stay with BYC. The reason for our rules is to provide guidelines to ensure an enjoyable visit with us.

Under no circumstances shall Bremerton Yacht Club docks be used to embark or disembark charters, or to load or unload provisions in connection with such charters.

Please note: Bremerton Yacht Club (BYC) regulations extend mooring privileges to members from reciprocal yacht clubs subject to space available under the following conditions:

1. Visiting yachts register at the pier gate. There is also a guest registry in the club house. It would be nice if that was signed also.

STORE HOURS (subject to change)
Tuesday through Saturday: 0900 to 1300 and
1530 to 1700 Hrs.

2. 30 A power is available at \$3/day/cord. All auxiliary equipment should be OFF between 0800 and 2200 unless departing.

3. No open fires or barbecues on the docks.

4. Please keep animals on leash and clean up after them.

5. Guests' mooring privileges are at the guests' risk and neither Bremerton Yacht Club nor its members shall be liable for any loss or damage while guests are moored at BYC.

6. Permission is given to BYC to move any guest boat if they find it necessary and boats

using BYC moorage facilities may be rafted to optimize use of moorage space.

7. Guests are limited to two weeks moorage per calendar year. The first 72 hours are complimentary except power hook up and key deposit. Additional days are \$5.00/day exclusive of power.

8. Visiting yachts fly your club's burgee while moored at BYC.

9. In these regulations, a "reciprocal visitor" is a member of another yacht club with which BYC has current reciprocal visiting privileges. A current list is maintained at the pier gate and with the Facilities Manager.

10. The fee and days/year regulations shall not apply to any visitor mooring at BYC as a part of a regatta or other yachting event hosted by BYC or a cruise or event approved by BYC. All other regulations apply.

11. Nothing in these regulations shall operate to prevent the BYC Commodore or any BYC Flag Officer in his absence from permitting, in special circumstances, moorage privileges beyond those set forth herein.

12. Please display your paid receipt visibly on a dockside window. This is the top half of the envelope that you filled out at the pier gate.
