The membership of BVYC accepts your reciprocity with the Cathlamet Yacht Club, and offers you reciprocal privileges at the Port of Brownsville. As you know BVYC is located at the Port of Brownsville, which is located on the Port Orchard Straits between Bremerton and Keyport.

Reciprocal guests to BVYC may receive moorage as stated in the enclosed Reciprocal Policy. Availability is on a first come first served basis, and guests requesting reciprocal must fly their club's burgee at all times, and comply with the Port of Brownsville Marina rules, a copy is enclosed. When registering for reciprocal, moorage guests must present a current club membership card. The Port of Brownsville has reciprocal moorage forms, and can be contacted on VHF channel 16/66. The Port of Brownsville operates 7 days a week, year-round, in winter and summer hours.

For your information, a map of the Marina, showing the location of guest moorage, is also enclosed. Moorage facilities include, power (at an additional fee), fresh water, restrooms, and the Brownsville Deli and Store. Laundry, garbage, and recycle are onsite. Diesel and gasoline are available at the fuel dock at the end of "A" dock. Pump out facilities are located on the end of the North Breakwater, as you come into the Marina, and further in the Marina on the main dock, closer to shore. Effective upon receipt, the following policy will pertain to Reciprocal Moorage paid by Brownsville Yacht Club for eligible visiting reciprocating yacht clubs defined in the attached list. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements:

Reciprocal Moorage Policy

Brownsville Yacht Club, in an agreement with the Port of Brownsville, agrees to provide payment for reciprocal moorage to approved Yacht Clubs, not to exceed **\$200 per month** with the following stipulations:

1. Reciprocal moorage will be limited to two (2) vessels per day, regardless of the number of visiting clubs on any one (1) day. This agreement is available to eligible yacht clubs on the reciprocal moorage list provided by Brownsville Yacht Club.
2. The total per day will not exceed 90 linear feet of breakwater moorage space, and rafting is not permitted in reciprocal moorage slips.
3. The visiting vessels will pay electrical fees, and any other fees than actual moorage fees, and Brownsville Yacht Club will not be responsible for damage any Port of Brownsville property or for the conduct of personnel or animals on visiting vessels. Visiting vessels must have a burgee visible on the craft, and valid membership card of the reciprocating yacht club in the owner's name. Port of Brownsville moorage forms must be filled out completely, and signed by both the owner of the vessel, and a Port of Brownsville employee.
4. Individual vessels are limited to **two (2) reciprocal moorage days per calendar month, and no more than four (4) moorage days per calendar year (January to December)**. Brownsville Yacht Club agrees to provide the Port of Brownsville a list of those vessels that have exceeded the yearly limit, as soon as that limit has been identified. This list will be modified as required.
5. Vessels with slips or boathouses (available or subleased) at the Port Of Brownsville are not authorized Brownsville Yacht Club reciprocal.
6. Brownsville Yacht Club agrees to provide the Port of Brownsville forms, which will allow reasonable control of reciprocal moorage on a daily and monthly basis.
7. The Port of Brownsville will provide the monthly billing, which includes the reciprocal moorage forms, with vessel names, reciprocating yacht club, and length of stay, to the Brownsville Yacht Club Vice Commodore for validation of reciprocal agreement. In return the Vice Commodore will then forward, with recommendation to pay (if valid) to the Treasurer for payment to the Port Of Brownsville in an amount not to exceed the \$200 dollar monthly agreed upon limit.
8. Brownsville Yacht Club will not honor payment to the Port of Brownsville for reciprocal moorage in excess of two (2) vessels on any one (1) day.

Brownsville Marina Rules

Use of Port facilities is evidence of the user's consent to abide by all the Port of Brownsville Rules, and Regulations, including the following:

1. All Guest Moorage MUST be paid in advance – See the Harbor Master for moorage forms.
2. No Skateboarding, Skating, Rollerblading, or bicycling on Marina premises.
3. Recreational swimming or SCUBA diving around the boats or docks is dangerous and not allowed.
4. Loud, boisterous, lewd, or lascivious conduct is not permitted.
5. Dogs and Cats must be on a leash or carried. Owners are responsible for picking up after and controlling their pets.
6. No objects of any kind may be left on the walkways, breakwaters, or finger piers.
7. Boats must be kept in seaworthy condition.
8. Adults will be responsible for the supervision of their children while in the Marina.
9. Proceed at minimal speed in the Marina – NO WAKE please.
10. Return dock carts to designated areas.
11. Store your dingy in a manner as not to bother your neighbor.
12. Don't discharge sewage into the water.
13. Anyone found violating these rules will be directed to leave.
