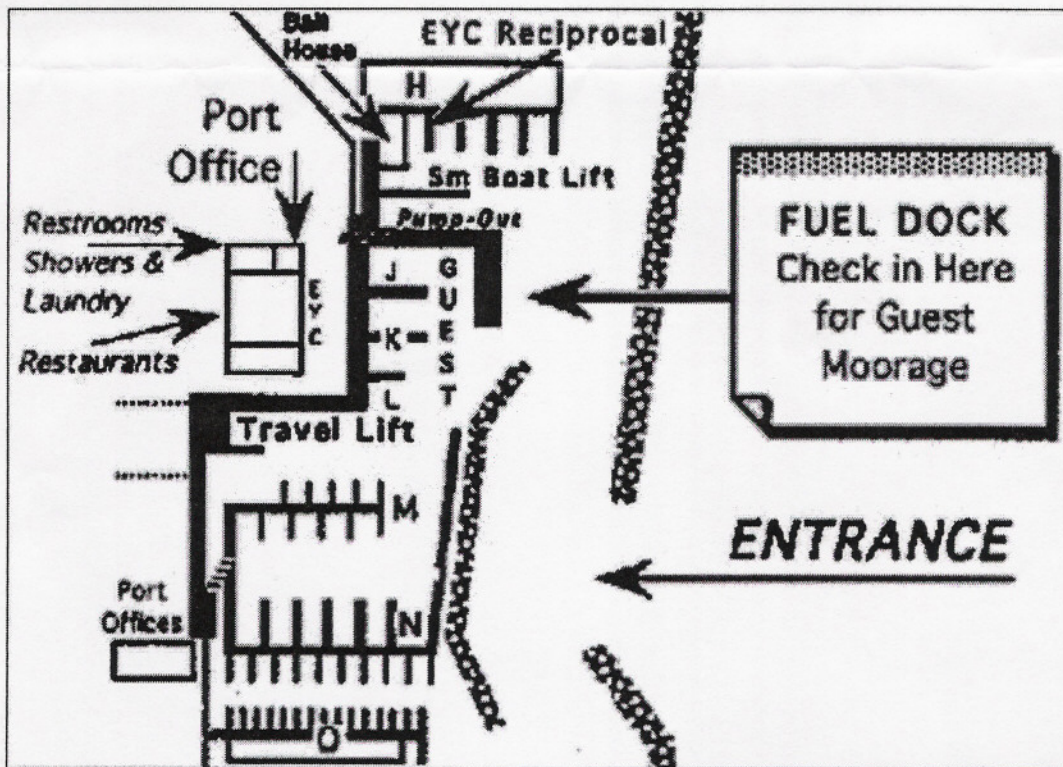

EDMONDS YACHT CLUB Reciprocal

Reciprocal moorage is located in the marina at the base of "H" Dock on the north side. Boats must be tied stern to dock - no exceptions. There is a 48' boat length restriction & 48 hour limit. Please register at dock & post registration card on aft of boat.

DAILY RATE: \$5.00 per day for power (subject to change)

This is a private moorage only available to members of reciprocal yacht clubs!

Visiting yacht clubs must have reciprocal privileges and you MUST fly your burgee!
