Upon entering Drayton Harbor, Blaine Marina is the first entrance to port and is marked by a red triangle. The sign also points the way to the transient float, the long float directly in front of the office. Contact the harbor office on VHF 68.

We request that you comply with the following:

- o Obey all posted rules
- o Clear customs if entering from Canada at Point Roberts
- o Register your reciprocal with IYC at the Harbor Master's office
- o Fly your yacht club burgee

Marina facilities:

Power, fuel, gas, diesel, water, laundry, pump out, washrooms, showers and vessel repair facilities.

Blaine, Washington facilities:

Chandlery, mechanical and electrical repairs, hardware, restaurants, bars, groceries.

For vessels returning to or entering Canada, customs clearance is available at the White Rock pier in Semiahmoo Bay.

If your cruising season plans include visiting this area, we would be pleased to have you enjoy our reciprocal arrangements.
