## 2011 – Mukilteo Yacht Club Reciprocal Policy

MYC extends reciprocal privileges at the Port of Everett (POE) Guest Docks. Visitors are to check in with POE Dockmaster upon arrival.

Members of Reciprocal Yacht Clubs are provided ...

- Up to one (1) night of moorage paid by MYC per vessel per month.
- Up to two (2) slips per night on a first come first serve basis if space is available.
- Up to three (3) nights per calendar year per vessel.

We ask that ...

- Visitors present their valid Yacht Club Membership card and enter their Membership Number at POE check in.
- Your Club have current MYC reciprocal privileges and be listed on the MYC Reciprocal List at the POE office
- Visitors fly your Club burgee.

These privileges are good until cancelled. Be sure to visit with the POE web site below for Guest Dock locations and additional Marina activity information. New this summer are free shuttles to and from the Tulalip Casino/Resort and access to the outlet stores.
