**Note: Owners of visiting boats, while they are berthed at NYC, must certify that their vessel does have valid Third Party Liability Insurance with at least \$1,000,000 minimum coverage.**

Visitors are requested to register upon arrival at the club office between the hours of 0800 and 1700 September thru June and until 2100 for July and August. Reciprocal moorage is available year round at the club. There are many services available nearby. A complete information sheet is enclosed for your convenience.

***Please note summer visitor moorage is now restricted to K and L docks from April 15 to October 15<sup>th</sup>; specifically, 400 feet outside the east and south breakwater.***

Upon arrival, please proceed to the 'visitor check in zone', marked by yellow paint, approximately 45 feet in length, situated at the southern end of H dock for vessels to temporary tie up to. (See attached map). This will allow visitors to dock, contact the staff, and **with assistance**, be allocated any inside space, if available. Otherwise, moorage is available on the outside of K and L floats on a first come, first served basis. Sorry, no reservations.

We ask that your members, **upon check-in present valid yacht club cards**, pick up their Nanaimo Visitor Package, to fly their Club Burgee and hope everyone has a pleasant stay in Nanaimo.

In addition, I would ask that you please complete and return the attached questionnaire, so that our members who may wish to use your reciprocal facilities have all the necessary information.
