The location of our reciprocal slip is at the Port Townsend Boat Haven and reciprocity is valid until revoked. A second slip may be available during the summer months. No reservations are accepted for reciprocal slips. Currently one night is free; subsequent nights at marina rates. The limit is one night per month and two nights per calendar year.

The Boat Haven is located west of the Port Townsend-Keystone ferry dock and is entered between a rock breakwater and a piling wave-break. Contact the Boat Haven as you are nearing the marina on VHF channel 66A, 09, or 16 with the size of your vessel and ask if a reciprocal slip is available. The phone numbers are 800-228-2803 or 360-385-2355. Immediately after docking you must check in with your current Yacht Club membership card and you must fly your burgee. The dockmaster's office is located next to the boat launch ramp at the head of the fuel dock.

Power is available, as are restrooms, showers, laundry, pumpout, and portapotty dump. Customs clearance is available by appointment. A haulout up to 300 tons is available with numerous repair facilities on-site. A large Safeway supermarket is a short walk away as are several restaurants, coffee shops, and chandleries. Public transportation and taxis are available to the downtown area.
